ABOUT THE INSEEC BBA

The INSEEC BBA program is offered in two cities (Bordeaux and Lyon) and trains students over four years to become professionals in various fields (Marketing, Finance, International Business, and others).

The international dimension of the INSEEC BBA program is reflected in the languages of teaching (English and French), the international internships and the mandatory academic study abroad.

The international aspect of this program is also revealed in the annual organization of an International Week to welcome international speakers on a special theme that interests our students.

KEY INFORMATION ABOUT THE 2023 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL WEEK

Since the 2000s, CSR has become a major topic of interest for companies of all sizes and sectors (*Acquier and Aggeri, 2008; Meier and Schier, 2017*). The practice of CSR in French companies is diverse, and the education of the new generation in management tools and evaluation of the effectiveness of these CSR practices is becoming more necessary than ever for all educational institutions.

Aware of the importance of CSR issues, the INSEEC BBA program includes courses and pedagogical activities that allow students to acquire the necessary skills in this area.

In this perspective, the 2023 edition of the international week is dedicated to raising student awareness regarding the practices and issues of CSR on an international scale.

This event is an opportunity to bring together professors, professionals, and experts from diverse educational institutions to share their knowledge with our students and exchange with our professors on the following theme.

Corporate social responsibility: at the crossroads of the today's business priorities.



Speakers' contributions can take the form of a workshop, a course or a seminar intended for 2nd-Year INSEEC BBA students. All 2nd-Year students have obtained 90 ECTS credits in Business Administration and have demonstrated their understanding of the fundamental notions of Finance, Management, and Marketing.
